Description:	<p>The Appointments Council (AC) branch of the College of Trades Appointments Council and Classification Roster (COTACCR) is seeking applications for individuals to serve as members of the College's Roster of Adjudicators. The Roster of Adjudicators is composed of employee and employer representatives from each of the construction, industrial, motive power and service trade sectors.</p> <p>The College is a professional regulatory body established with a legislated mandate to, among other things, establish review panels to determine journeyman to apprentice ratios for trades subject to ratios. A review panel is composed of three members chosen from the Roster of Adjudicators. Those appointed to the roster shall be capable of, and shall act, in a neutral and impartial manner. Members shall serve and protect the public interest and shall act in accordance with such conflict of interest rules as may be prescribed by the College's by-laws.</p> <p>Review panels are responsible for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Determining the appropriate journeyman to apprentice ratios for trades subject to ratios; and • Reporting their decisions to the College's Board of Governors.
Qualifications:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Analytical, conceptual, and problem-solving skills to review and analyze all evidence and submissions objectively and thoroughly. • Ability to formulate reasoned decisions and communicate them orally and in writing which reflect a solid grasp of the issues and the relevant statutory provisions and applicable policies and guidelines. • Understanding of government values and a commitment to working within government's accountability framework. • Knowledge of the <i>Ontario College of Trades and Apprenticeship Act, 2009</i>, the Ontario College of Trades and/or the skilled trades and apprenticeship is an asset. <p><i>Note: Members appointed to the Roster of Adjudicators may also apply for appointment to the Classification Roster of the COTACCR.</i></p>
Terms:	Per legislated requirements, appointment is for an initial term of up to three years and may be renewed. No member may serve for more than six consecutive years but a member is eligible for reappointment after one year's absence from the roster of adjudicators.
Time Commitment:	It is anticipated that, if appointed to a ratio review panel, members of the Roster of Adjudicators may participate in two or more ratio reviews per year, subject to availability. Note: While ratio review panels comprise members of the Roster of Adjudicators, there is no assurance that a Roster of Adjudicators appointee will be appointed to a ratio review panel.

Remuneration:	The per diem rate for serving on a journey person to apprentice ratio review panel is \$665 for the Chair and \$400 for the remaining panel members.
